# Recipe of the Month:

# Coconut Cream Eggs

#### INGREDIENTS:

- · I package (8 ounces) cream cheese, softened
- · I tablespoon butter, softened
- · 4 cups confectioners' sugar
- · I cup sweetened shredded coconut
- · 2 cups semisweet chocolate chips
- · I tablespoon shortening

### **DIRECTIONS:**

I. In a bowl, beat cream cheese and butter until smooth. Add sugar and coconut. Refrigerate for I-I/2 hours or until easy to handle. Using hands dusted with confectioners' sugar, mold rounded tablespoonfuls of coconut mixture into egg shapes. Place on a waxed paper-lined baking sheet. Freeze for 2 hours or until slightly firm.

2. Melt chocolate chips and shortening. Remove eggs from the freezer a few at a time; dip into chocolate mixture until completely coated. Return to waxed paper; refrigerate until hardened. Store in the refrigerator.
